4. Discussion to Add Communities to League
a) Baseball $3^{\text {rd }}-8^{\text {th }}$ Grades - Bloomington baseball - passed unanimously
b) Softball $3^{\text {rd }}-8{ }^{\text {th }}$ Grades - Belmont softball - passed unanimously, WI Heights softball - passed unanimously
5. Softball and Baseball Rule changes for 2019
a) $3 / 4$ SB - IF COACH COMES IN TO PITCH

1) A coach should start their pitch from the rubber.
2) Player pitchers who are now just the fielder should stay with one foot in the circle.
3) Coaches are limited to a max of 4 pitches to each batter unless last pitch is a foul ball. Player still strikes out on any combination of 3 strikes from player or coach.
b) $3 / 4 \mathrm{SB}$ - Outfielders including the rover $/ 4^{\text {th }}$ outfielder must play $>=20$ feet behind baseline.
c) $5 / 6 \mathrm{SB}$ - Home plate closed on overthrow to pitcher.
d) $5 / 6 \mathrm{SB}-3$ innings is a complete game, if shortened due to weather, 2.5 innings if home team is ahead.
e) $7 / 8 \mathrm{SB}$ - First two innings are closed, limited to 4 runs with no continuation.
f) $7 / 8 \mathrm{SB}-$ Nine players on defense.
g) $7 / 8 \mathrm{SB}-$ Need to bat 9 or bat everyone (the bench).
h) $3 / 4$ and $5 / 6$ BB - Can use 2-5/8" bat, must be USA stamped. USSSA stamped 2-1/4" still legal
i) ALL BASEBALL - 8 inning limit per pitcher per day. (Usually only Saturday of tournament)
j) $\quad B B$ and $S B$ - Once the pitcher is near the rubber with the ball, the runner CANNOT advance past the next base.
k) BB and SB - ALL CLOSED INNINGS ARE LIMITED TO 4 RUNS, WITH NO CONTINUATION.
