Softball VP – Randy Hoffman

-Seeding for last year's tournament was skewed by coaches not reporting scores on the website. PLEASE REPORT YOUR SCORES! Winning team must report the score. Rule passed last fall: Any team with 2 or more unreported scores by the deadline, the current head coach will not be allowed to coach the next year unless a \$150 fine is paid to the SWCL. Tournament Time – Winning Team PLEASE REPORT YOUR SCORE PRIOR TO LEAVING THE FIELD. It will help get the bracket updated much faster. THE SWCL should not have to track coaches down to report scores. Please do your part. Texting works great!

 - a) Reedsburg
 - No representation present at meeting. Motion was made to not vote in. Seconded and approved.
 - b) Darlington
 - No representation present at meeting. Motion was made to not vote in. Seconded and approved.
- 6. Softball and Baseball Rule Changes Tabled to Spring Meeting

Baseball & Softball:

- a. Evaluating the need to report rosters if other coaches are unable to see them prior to the game played.
 - -Motion was made to continue submitting rosters. Was seconded and motion was approved.
- b. Start League games June 1st due to conflicts with high school.
 - -Motion was made to start after June 1. Was seconded and the motion was not approved. Will start as normal and to end the year in mid-July.

Baseball:

- a. All grade levels to pitch from a mound.
 - -Motion was made to only have Grades 5 and above in scope. Motion was seconded and approved.
 - -Motion was made to table the vote till the fall meeting with the following changes: Mounds can be used if both coaches agree to use them. If a coach is not comfortable using a portable mound, their team will not be forced to use one. Motion to table was seconded and passed.

Softball:

- a. Clarifying questions regarding 3/4 grade Coach's 4th pitch.
 - -If a player fouls off on the 4th Coach's pitch it will be treated like a foul ball on a second strike. The batter will be allowed another pitch. If the batter does not swing on the 4th pitch, the batter is out.
- b. Questions regarding hit by pitch at the 3/4 grade Coaches hitting batters vs pitchers hitting batters.
 - -The batter must make an attempt to avoid the pitch. They cannot just let the ball hit them and be awarded a base. Please note that the umpire makes the final call.

7. Rules Review from 2021

Baseball and Softball:

- a. 2nd Graders may be brought up during the season to participate in 3/4 Grade to help make a complete team. It will be required that the player participate in that community's rec program.
- b. There were issues with coaches delayed in reporting scores if at all. This caused issues with team seeding in the SWCL bracket. A motion was brought up to make the following rule: Any team with 2 or more

unreported scores by the deadline, the current head coach will not be allowed to coach the next year unless a \$150 fine is paid to the SWCL.

c. For 3/4 grade, no outs will be taken for less than 10 players in the tournament. Teams can play with 8 players.

Baseball

- a. Host seeding for SWCL Tournament. All winner bracket and losing bracket games will be played at the host site Thursday – Saturday. This is the same process that Softball uses for the SWCL tournament.
- b. For 3/4 Grade, base runners can lead off when it leaves the pitcher's hand. The base runner is not allowed to advance to the next base under any circumstances. It will be a force out at the base the runner led off from if any play attempts are made. If base runners leave base too early, a warning will be made the first time. Any additional times it will be an out.
- For 5/6 Grade the field dimensions be changed to 70-foot bases.
 Pitching Rubber will be at 50 Feet. Home is open. Regular leading off.
 Dropped 3rd strike is out. Balk warning, no advancement.
- d. first two innings are closed to a limit of 4 runs, all remaining innings are open for 3rd through 6th Grades.
- e. All Grade Levels, catchers cannot come into pitch unless there is an injury.

Reminder from 2021: USE OF ILLEGAL BATS (BASEBALL ONLY!)
Use of an illegal bat, (ie. USSSA bat of any size, or 2 3/4" diameter bat) will be punished as

follows.

First offense: Offender is out and ENDS THE INNING.

2nd offense: TEAM FORFEITS THE GAME.

3rd offense: TEAM IS BANNED FROM LEAGUE TOURNAMENT PLAY.

Note: Wood bats are legal at all levels

*All offenses must be reported to the League Commissioner and VP of baseball.

Softball:

- a. First two innings are closed to a limit of 4 runs, all remaining innings are open for 3rd through 6th Grades.
- b. All Grade Levels, catchers cannot come into pitch unless there is an injury.
 - -i.e., a catcher cannot come into pitch within the same inning unless there is an injury. If a player is not catching that inning, they can pitch.
- c. For 7/8 Grade softball. All innings are open. 12 run rule after 3 innings, 10 run rule after 5.
- d. For 5/6 Grade softball. Home is open.
- e. If the ball hits the ground on a pitch, the batter must make an attempt to avoid getting hit by the ball. If the batter does not make an attempt, they will not be rewarded 1st base.
